

LICENSING CHECKLIST FOR: PRE-LICENSE INSTRUCTOR

All the following items are required and must be completed in order to obtain a license for a Mortgage Pre-License Instructor. If the application is not complete at the time of submission, <u>it</u> <u>will delay approval and could result in a denial</u>. Fees are nonrefundable and are due at the time of application submission. *Application must be made at least 30 days prior to first course offering*.

For 15-Hour Mortgage Loan Originator: 1.

Affirmation of high school diploma or equivalent. 2.
□ Evidence of five years' experience in the residential mortgage industry within the past ten years or relevant college-level education related to the course subject. 3. \square Evidence of twelve months full-time teaching experience or participation in the two-day Instructor Development Workshop. 4.

Evidence of successfully passing the Lending Manager Exam at an instructor level. 5. Documentation for "yes" answers as required. 7. \(\sigma\) Non-refundable \$75 application fee. For 40-Hour Lending Manager Course, include all items listed above and the following additional items: 8. D Evidence of two years' experience in each of the subjects you intend to teach, including Management of Residential Mortgage Office, Mortgage Lending Law, Advanced Appraisal, and Advanced Finance. (See R162-2c-203(d)) 9. Devidence of successfully passing the Lending Manager exam at an instructor level.
